- 4. Matters Arising from the previous Minutes:
- 5.1 Parish Council website Other parish councils seem to have employed professional designers to set up their websites so that is something we will make enquiries about to see what the set up and maintenance costs would be and how the parish council could still input information.
- 5.2 Stainton & Stainton Grove in Bloom Some of the planters/plants are still in reasonable shape but others have suffered through lack of watering. Some winter pansies will be bought and planted in those planters that need them to give some colour then JT will ensure the planters at the well are watered and JB will do the same for the ones at West Farm.
- 5.3 JB reported that the first of the three flower troughs ordered from the quarry is almost ready for viewing. When it's ready he'll take a photo and let the other councillors see the result.
- 5.4 ROSPA playground safety report. Items raised in the report include the trees overhanging the play area and the general surface of the playground. Chris Stamp will be asked to quote for power washing the surface and pruning the overhanging branches.
- 5.5 Speed signage The cost will be £2735.00 plus VAT. This will include a training session in its use, an extra battery and an additional connection/fixing kit.
- 5.6 Encroachment on village green this complaint has proved to be unfounded as the grassed area in question is not registered or designated as a village green so no further action by the council is necessary. The complaint was originally made to DCC so they have advised the complainant of this.
